

National, Regional, and Leadership Crew Schedule Breakdown

For Regional and National Crews, use the following guidance when planning for your program:

	Travel Days	Work Days	Rest/Education Days
2 week	2	10	2
3 week	2	16	3
4 week	2	22	4
5 week	2	28	5

Remember that these programs no longer have an assumed multi-day 'rec trip' at the end of the program. Instead, we ask that Crew Leader discuss the possibility with their agency partner and the SCA Program Manager and plan according to their expectations. Some partners will encourage the crew to take an additional recreation-based trip at the end of their program, which may entail hiking out from a backcountry location. Even if CLs, agency partners and SCA staff agree to do a recreation-based trip in addition to the allotted rest/education days listed above, the trip should still meet specific educational goals and outcomes related to SCA's mission. Contact your Program Manager with any questions.

For Leadership (tuition-based) Crews, use the following guidance when planning for your program:

	Travel Days	Work Days	Rest/Education Days	Recreation Trip
3 week	2	12	4	3
4 week	2	17	5	4

These programs have more education days built in to accommodate the more rigorous focus on Wilderness Medicine curriculum and leadership topics and opportunities. A multi-day recreation trip will be planned for the end of the program. Contact your Program Manager with any questions.
